Discipline policy

In most cases, asking a child to stop their disruptive behavior and taking coins away from them after a warning is sufficient, but in some cases further action must be taken. In these cases, we have implemented a “Three Strike” policy. A strike may be assigned to a child for the following reasons:

- Multiple classroom disruptions
- Foul language
- Continued disrespect of adults
- Bullying/Physical abuse
- Leaving the classroom without permission
- Other instances at the leader’s discretion

Strikes that are given close to the end of the evening can carry over to the next week.

If a child receives a third strike the “Three Strikes” form is to be filled out and the club coordinator will contact the child’s parent/guardian. That child will not be allowed to attend clubs for the next three weeks. On the fourth week the child will be permitted to resume attending clubs if the “Three Strike” form is returned with a parent/guardian’s signature.

Remember, we try to discipline in a loving manner, and we do not physically discipline children.
