Be a BLESSing in Your Neighborhood!

This fall, and leading to the first Sunday in Advent, we're in a Sunday morning sermon series called How to BLESS Your Neighbor. Following the acronym BLESS, we're learning a very simply way to share your faith with our family, friends and neighbors in a very nonthreatening way. BLESS stands for:

BEGIN with Prayer—pray for five people every day.

LISTEN with Care—Most people just need someone to listen.

EAT Together—Share a meal together to get to know your neighbors.

SERVE in Love—Look for ways to help your neighbors. Look for needs.

SHARE your story—Be alert to an opportunity to share your story about Jesus.



You can use the BLESS app to adopt 50 people in your neighborhood and pray for them, 5 people each day. It's easy and a great way to BLESS your family, friends and neighbors. Just scan the code above and follow the directions. Make sure you put Fairview Avenue Brethren in Christ Church as your church home.


Join us for our annual festive celebration! Christmas carols and handheld candles at 7 pm in the Sanctuary. Light refreshments will be available after the service.


This Advent season, we'll journey together through a series called Advent Paintings—a time of worship and reflection, designed to draw our hearts toward the coming King.
